

# WHAT'S IN THE HOUSE BILL

Key provisions in House Democrats' policing overhaul legislation:

---

## CHOKEHOLDS/NO-KNOCK WARRANTS

---

Bans the use of chokeholds and no-knock warrants in federal drug cases. Conditions certain federal law enforcement funding on adopting chokehold bans and the use of no-knock warrants in drug cases.

---

## QUALIFIED IMMUNITY

---

Ends the practice of qualified immunity for law enforcement officers, which would allow individuals to pursue civil damages if police officers violate their constitutional rights.

---

## USE OF FORCE

---

- Requires that deadly force be used only as a last resort. Changes the evaluation standard from whether the force was “reasonable” to whether it was “necessary.”
  - Conditions certain federal grants to local law enforcement agencies on their adoption of use of force standards.

## REPORTING

---

- Creates a national police misconduct registry and mandates that state and local law enforcement agencies report use of force data by race, sex, disability and age.
  - Requires the Department of Justice to collect data on investigatory actions and detentions by federal law enforcement agencies; the racial distribution of drug charges; the use of deadly force by and against law enforcement officers; and traffic and pedestrian stops and detentions.

## BODY CAMERAS

---

- Requires federal uniformed police officers to wear body cameras and mandates that state and local law enforcement use existing federal funds to make sure officers wear body cameras.
  - Requires marked federal police vehicles to have dashboard cameras.
