



Overview

The John D. and Catherine T. MacArthur Foundation is a private, independent grantmaking institution dedicated to helping groups and individuals foster lasting improvement in the human condition. Through the support it provides, the Foundation fosters the development of knowledge, nurtures individual creativity, helps strengthen institutions, helps improve public policy, and provides information to the public, primarily through support for public interest media. The Foundation makes grants through four programs and by making program-related investments.

The <u>Program on Global Security and Sustainability</u> focuses on international issues, including peace and security, conservation and sustainable development, population and reproductive health, and human rights. The program also supports initiatives in <u>Russia</u> and Nigeria, particularly concerning the improvement of higher education. International offices are located in Mexico, India, Nigeria, and Russia.

The Program on Human and Community Development operates primarily within the United States. Issues of interest to the program include community development; regional policy; affordable housing, with a particular emphasis on the preservation of rental housing; and system reform in education, juvenile justice, and mental health.

The <u>General Program</u> supports public interest media, including public radio and the production of independent documentary film; and makes grants to arts and cultural institutions in the Chicago area.

The MacArthur Fellows Program awards

five-year, unrestricted fellowships to individuals across all ages and fields who show exceptional merit and promise of continued creative work. It is limited to U.S. citizens and other residents of the United States.

Program-Related Investments (PRIs) are loans and equity investments provided at below-market rates for projects that advance the philanthropic objectives of the Foundation. Used primarily in the program on Human and Community Development, most pris support U.S.-based community development financial institutions, organizations that provide affordable banking services for individuals and financing for small businesses, low-cost housing, and community facilities.

The Foundation benefits in its work from diversity at all levels of its operations. In working with other organizations and individuals, the Foundation values those who understand and share its commitment to diversity.

One of the nation's ten largest private philanthropic foundations, MacArthur has awarded more than \$3 billion in grants since it began operations in 1978, and today has assets of more than \$4 billion. Annual grantmaking totals approximately \$185 million. The Foundation believes its grantmaking is most effective when focused upon a relatively few areas of work, combined with sufficient resources over a long enough period of time to make a measurable difference.

John D. MacArthur (1897-1978) developed and owned Bankers Life and Casualty Company and other businesses, as well as considerable property in Florida and New York. His wife <u>Catherine</u> (1909-1981) held positions in many of these companies and served as a director of the Foundation.

- Amount of funding requested from MacArthur and total cost (estimates are acceptable)

You are welcome to enclose attachments that you feel would help the Foundation understand your project.

The Foundation's response

We will send you an acknowledgment that your letter of inquiry was received, and we will direct it to the appropriate staff members for review. If as a result of that review the Foundation concludes that there is no prospect of Foundation funding, we will notify you promptly.

If the Foundation decides that your project might qualify for a grant, we will contact you to discuss next steps and what further information is required.

All material submitted becomes the property of the MacArthur Foundation. The Foundation sometimes submits inquiries or proposals for confidential outside review.

As is now the case with most charities in the United States who make grants to organizations based outside the United States, the Foundation checks the names of foreign based grantees, and the principal officers and directors of such grantees, against one or more lists maintained by the U.S. government, the European Union, and the United Nations, which contain the names determined by such entities to be terrorist organizations or individual terrorists. This process is a result of legislation passed by the U.S. Congress, Executive Orders issued by the President, and suggested guidelines issued by the U.S. Department of the Treasury.
